These challenges are **not isolated issues**, but part of a larger socio-economic ecosystem where poverty, health vulnerability, gender inequality, digital exclusion, and environmental stress reinforce one another.

- While SWELA has been actively addressing these concerns through education, training, healthcare outreach, and welfare initiatives, **the growing demand for these services far exceeds existing resources**. Increasing participation from communities, rising awareness among women, and greater expectations from society have made it clear that **incremental efforts alone are no longer sufficient**.
- To respond effectively to these realities, SWELA must transition from **impactful yet limited initiatives** to a **comprehensive, well-resourced, and scalable empowerment ecosystem**. This transition requires enhanced financial support, strategic partnerships, and investment in infrastructure, human capital, and digital systems.
