CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

1. Academic & Attendance Mandates:-

- **Minimum Attendance:** Maintain a minimum of 75% physical attendance in each course to qualify for SPPU examinations.
- **Medical Leave:** Submit valid medical certificates within 3 working days of returning to campus.
- **Identification:** Wear the official college identity card visibly at all times on the campus premises.
- **Professional Attire:** Dress in the prescribed uniform at all times on the campus premises.

2. Campus Decorum & Discipline: -

- **Substance Prohibition:** Maintain a 100% smoke-free, drug-free, and alcohol-free campus environment.
- **Digital Etiquette:** Keep mobile phones switched off or on silent mode inside classrooms and the library.
- **Property Care:** Handle library books, computer lab equipment, and college property with utmost care.
- **Social Media Use:** Refrain from posting malicious, defamatory, or fake news about the fellow students, institute or staff online.

3. Zero-Tolerance Policies :-

- **Anti-Ragging:** Ragging is a criminal offense under the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999. Violators face immediate expulsion and police action.
- **Sexual Harassment:** Any unwelcome behaviour will be strictly prosecuted under the POSH Act and SPPU internal guidelines.

4) Implementation & Disciplinary Proceedings :-

- **Reporting:** Any violation of this code must be reported in writing to the Principal or the respective committee head.
- **Enquiry:** The concerned committee will issue a Show Cause Notice to the accused, ensuring a fair opportunity to be heard.
- **Penal Actions:** Depending on gravity, penalties may include written warnings, financial fines, suspension, or recommendation to SPPU for rustication.
